

Science Essay Competition for school children: Grade 10 and above

Organized by: Committee for popularization of Science of the SLAAS

The purpose of this competition is to popularize Science among school children, hone their science writing skills and stimulate children to think.

Essay Topics

English: The Digital Child: How Technology is Reshaping Lives of Children.

Rules for applicants

- The competition is open for students of grade 10 and above in Sri Lanka.
- Medium English /Sinhala / Tamil.
- One student can submit an essay in only one language.
- The principal / Head of the school must certify that the applicant is a student of his / her school and that the essay was written by the student.
- The essay must be written in clear handwriting or typewritten
- Essays written in illegible handwriting would be rejected.
- The essay should contain not less than 750 words and not more than 1000 words.
- Children of officials and members of the Council, statutory committees and other committees of SLAAS would not be eligible to participate.
- One student will be permitted to submit only one essay.

Awards

- Winners of 1st, 2nd and 3rd places would be selected from each province in all three languages.
- The school to which the student winning the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place attends would be regarded as the school winning the 1st, 2nd and 3rd places from the province.
- The winning Students and the winning schools would be awarded certificates at the annual sessions of the Sri Lanka Association for the Advancement of Science (SLAAS) which would be held in December 2024 in Colombo.
- The 1st place-winning essays and the photographs of the authors would be displayed as a poster during the annual sessions and on the SLAAS website.
- The decision of the SLAAS council regarding winners would be final.

How to participate

Complete the application form given below.

- Obtain certification from the principal / Head of the school that the applicant is a student of his / her school and that the assay was written by the student.
